Description of Unpaid/Unfinished Bonds Previously Approved by Voters of the Jurisdiction:

As of the 14th day of September, 2021, Independent School District No. 19, Pontotoc County, Oklahoma, has 2 General Obligation bond issue(s) outstanding:

\$2,285,000 Combined Purpose Bonds of 2020, dated February 1, 2020 (\$2,285,000 outstanding in principal as of the 14th day of September, 2021); and

\$1,560,000 Building Bonds of 2021, dated January 1, 2021 (\$1,560,000 outstanding in principal as of the 14th day of September, 2021).

The School District has \$6,240,000 in unissued building bonds authorized at an election held on the 1st day of April, 2014. These bonds will be used to complete the constructing, furnishing, equipping, and/or acquiring of a new classroom/storm shelter addition at the High School; improvements at the High School; roofing improvements at the High School; a new classroom/storm shelter addition at the Junior High School; improvements at Willard Grade Center; improvements at Hayes Grade Center; a multi-purpose classroom/storm shelter at Hayes Grade Center; improvements at the Junior High School; improvements at Washington Grade Center; and a new vocal music-band room/ storm shelter at Willard Grade Center.
