

#### School Safety:

All Tri-Township staff have the SchoolGuard active shooter alert app on their phones. If used, this app instantly alerts all on and off duty officers through the Hero911 Network. This app shortens notification time, which then shortens response time, and greatly improves the chance of saving lives. This is the ONLY federally approved emergency alert app in the country.
