

DELAC Minutes
October 15, 2021

1. Welcome and Introductions: Done
2. Reclassification update (Special Ed form): Kathy Diederich reviewed with members the form. The change on the form is that we are using benchmark percentage (40th percentile) as a part of the reclassification criteria instead of specific scores at each grade level. This will allow us to apply the percentage across the different benchmark platforms that are used such as SRI, STAR and Aimsweb.
3. ELPAC update student scores, annual notification letters - Kathy Diederich updated the team on the summative ELPAC scores that were released. Students who scored a 4 were going to be considered for reclassification after benchmarks and grades are posted. Students who can be reclassified will need to be done before we begin summative ELPAC testing in February. In addition, annual notification letters have been sent out letting parents know their students are in our ELD program. We are waiting for the list of LTEL/ARTEL students from the state.
4. Alternate ELPAC testing: Kathy Diederich discussed with the team we have approximately 4-5 students who are eligible for this test. Only students who have significant cognitive disabilities will be taking this test. This is the first time it will be given and will open up in November. We will use this data to determine if students with an IEP and EL can reclassify. The state is still working on calibrating the scores and plans to implement it fully for the school year 2022/2023.
5. Biliteracy Awards/Pathway to Biliteracy: Kathy Diederich shared that the seal of biliteracy is open to seniors. The due date for the application is March 4. The award ceremony is scheduled with the county on 4/27 and 4/28. At this time we are not sure if it will be in-person. The pathway to biliteracy is open to 8th graders. The due date for the application is 1/31. The paras at

each school site will make a presentation to the class to encourage students to participate.
