• The College in High School Program allows high school students to earn college credits while taking approved courses in high school. The following courses are approved for the College in High School program through Mount Aloysius College:

- Registration is open from February 1, 2025 and will close on February 22, 2025.
- You must be a **sophomore**, **junior**, **or senior** to register for a course(s) through Mount Aloysius College. To earn college credit, the student must register and pay for the course(s) by the deadline, earn at least a "C" average or better in the course(s) and attend school regularly.
 - Please note: If students in enrolled in Fall 2024 CHS Courses, they can jump to instruction #3 on the handout. There is no need to apply again. They simply login with their MAC username/password, add their courses for Spring, and make payment.

- Credits earned through our college in high school program have transferred to many colleges and universities. <u>YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR DETERMINING IF THE COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY IN WHICH</u> <u>YOU ARE INTERESTED IN ATTENDING ACCEPTS THE CREDITS</u>. The best way to do this is to contact the admissions office of the school you are interested in attending. You may obtain a copy of the Mount Aloysius College syllabus from your guidance counselor to have the college or university you plan to attend review for transfer approval.
- Once the course is completed and grades have been submitted to the college by your instructor or guidance counselor, a transcript may be obtained through the National Student Clearinghouse at <u>www.getmytranscript.com</u> and choose "hold for final grades" when the option arrives. Turnaround time for final transcripts takes approximately two to three weeks after completion of course.
