Did you know that there 574 federally recognized Indian Nations in the United States? Approximately 229 of these ethnically, culturally and linguistically diverse nations are located in Alaska; the other federally recognized tribes are located in 35 other states. Today, in the Little Theatre during both lunches, we will be learning about the Lakota Nation who live on or close to reservations in North and South Dakota and neighboring Minnesota, including the cities of Minneapolis and St. Paul. There are approximately 100,000 Lakota living today. The videos that you have the opportunity to view today will be an animated Ted Talk briefly explaining the history of the Lakota Nation followed by a film called "Lakota in America" which tells the perspective of a teenage member of the Lakota sharing their experience of growing up as a member of the Lakota Nation. Please get your lunch and join us at 11:00 a.m. or 12:00 p.m. in the Little Theatre. Remember, if you come to a viewing session during lunch, you will be eligible to watch the movie Dances with Wolves during the next week's half day on Wednesday. Join us in the Theatre tomorrow to learn more about Native American heritage.
