The following plan is intended to guide schools within the supervisory union with re-opening for in-person learning in the fall of 2021.

Rivendell Interstate School District is eligible for \$1,176,274.80 through the American Rescue Plan act, Elementary Secondary School Emergency Relief fund (ARP ESSER).
