Mrs. Hanna's TK - 3rd Grade



This was a fun week full of different activities. We enjoyed doing so many things. In social studies we learned about states then expanded and we looked at the United States of America and where it was in the world. Do you know that many of our amazing students cannot only name the states, but were more than willing to write them down on a United States map? I was very impressed! And they all have a state that they want to go and visit. We continued learning about where we live in the world and where we live in California, in a county called Shasta. They can look at a map and show you where they live.

We also spent time learning about crickets. How do crickets chirp? We learned about sound and that it is vibration that makes a sound. When we stretched a rubber band we observed that it made different sounds or different vibrations. Crickets have special skills-It is their wing's vibrations that we hear as a chirp. We also learned about high and low pitch.

This week was special because we got to learn about Easter. We made fun and engaging crafts. We had an Easter egg basket and Easter egg hunting time. We also read the book, *The Easter Egg*.

In math, kindergarten continued on with three dimensional shapes whether it's a cube, a cylinder or a cone. Some shapes can roll, some can stack and some can slide. In first grade, we are comparing lengths; what is longer, which is shorter and how do we put them in order? In second grade, we are continuing on with counting money whether we're counting coins or bills. In third grade we are starting with fractions. We are sorting out which shapes split into equal parts and which shapes do not.

Language arts is thriving. In kindergarten, we are learning about beginning and ending sounds. In first grade, we are learning about the pronouns- I and me - and when do you use which one – we will also be discussing possessive pronouns. We are continuing with forming past tense verbs in second grade and sometimes it can be as simple as just adding ed to a word. Sometimes they're a little bit harder. In third grade language arts, we are continuing to learn about forming past tense verbs. All of the students' reading skills are expanding so much! It's so lovely to see how eager they are for reading groups.

Every day is a gift when we get to learn and grow together! Enjoy today! Mrs. Hanna

Mrs. Hanna's class has been learning all about different rhythms.


Learning rhythms requires students to concentrate and pay attention to the details of each beat. This fosters the ability to focus and can help in other areas of learning, including reading and math.
