With approximately 75 million dollars available for Idaho LAUNCH funding, it is possible for this program to offer between 9,000 and 10,000 awards per year <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Graduate from an Idaho High School or equivalent</li> <li>• Be an Idaho resident</li> <li>• Be enrolled in or have applied to an in-demand career program at an eligible Idaho institution</li> <li>• Begin enrollment by Fall Semester after graduation, unless granted an extension</li> <li>• Complete a Career Pathway Plan</li> <li>• Review the approved list of eligible in-demand careers</li> </ul>	80% of tuition and fees up to \$8,000
<b>Oct 10</b>	U.S. Senate Youth	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Open to students in their junior or senior</li> </ul>	\$10,000
