(20 points): IXL Summer Boost: Math. Your child will receive a printed copy of the IXL Summer Boost: Math for his/her grade level. There are twenty days of review skills that need to be completed to a MINIMUM Smart Score of 90 ( 100 would be even better $\mathcal{O}$ ). Your child needs to document the date, time spent, and smart score for each of the twenty skills. The skills do not need to be completed in order and more than one skill may be completed per day.
