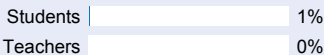

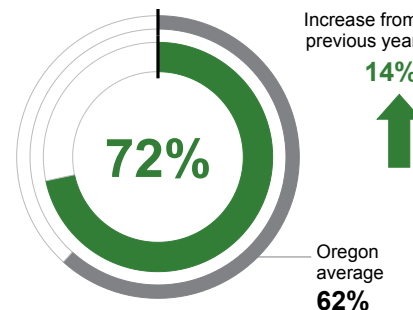
CLASS SIZE

REGULAR ATTENDERS

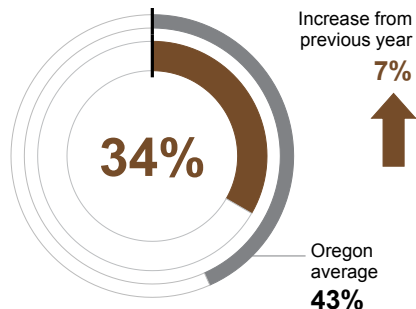
Students who attended more than 90% of their enrolled school days.

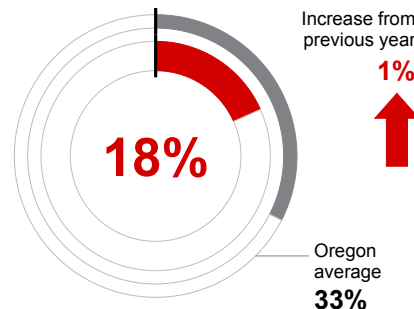
ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS

Students meeting state grade-level expectations.



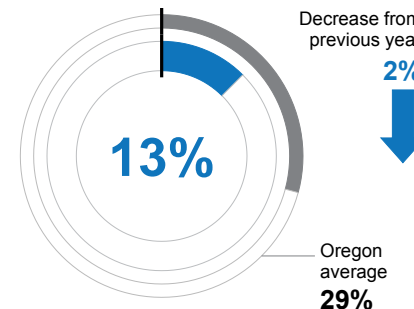
MATHEMATICS

School Goals

Our vision is for all learners to rise to the opportunities and challenges of the world. The District continues to support its athletic and co-curricular programs, including expanded options in music, visual arts, dance, and drama. Hilda Lahti Elementary works hard to build trusting relationships between parents, students, staff, and the community. We acknowledge the inherent worth of every child and believe that very interaction matters.

State Goals

The Oregon Department of Education is partnering with school districts and local communities to ensure a 90% on-time, four year graduation rate by 2027. To progress toward this goal, the state will prioritize efforts to improve attendance, provide a well-rounded education, invest in implementing culturally responsive practices, and promote continuous improvement to close opportunity and achievement gaps for historically and currently underserved students.

Safe & Welcoming Environment

Hilda Lahti Elementary School and Knappa Middle School share a safe and welcoming campus. Students are supported by a full time counselor, and a community connector. The staff maintains caring relationships with all students. Hilda Lahti Elementary is a Play Works school where students learn safe play through games, conflict resolution, and mentorship by "junior coaches." The school utilizes positive behavioral interventions and supports (PBIS). The school provides a weekend food backpack program for students who face economic challenges.

About Our School

BULLYING, HARASSMENT, AND SAFETY POLICIES

Hilda Lahti Elementary prohibits bullying, intimidation, and harassment. Students or parents who witness or experience any of these should immediately report them to the principal or Title IX coordinator (named on the District website). The school provides a counselor and community connector who can assist students with navigating these issues. Small class sizes and adults who know our children well are protective factors. The Play Works program helps students to cooperate with one another on the playground. The school is a positive behavioral intervention support school. The school reinforces a positive character trait of the month program. The community recently supported a bond which is helping with installation of safety equipment and features. There is a full time nurse.

EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Basketball (b/g), Volleyball, Football, Cross Country, Track & Field, Wrestling. The school also hosts youth recreational teams in basketball, volleyball, football, baseball, softball, wrestling, and soccer. The school provides after school academic support and clubs. A popular club at the school is Pokémon. Hilda Lahti Elementary also hosts a STEM club in association with Oregon State University.

PARENT ENGAGEMENT

Hilda Lahti Elementary welcomes parents as partners in students' education. The school has volunteer opportunities, an active Parent Club, and hosts parent conferences twice each year. Teachers routinely reach out to families regarding student successes and academic progress. The school hosts a monthly student recognition assembly where parents are invited.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

Knappa Schools are the hub of the community, hosting community meetings, sports, weddings, memorials, recreation, and worship. Knappa Middle School athletic events are well attended by community members of all ages. Knappa High School (next door) is an emergency sheltering facility. Knappa Schools Foundation partners with our schools to provide classroom resources and is supporting the purchase of our new playground. Knappa School District works hard to maintain civility in all interactions with families, employees, and the community.
