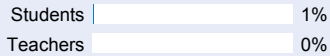

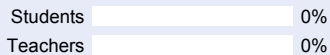

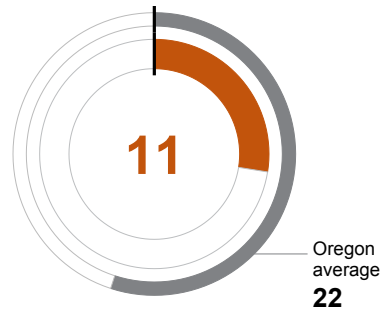

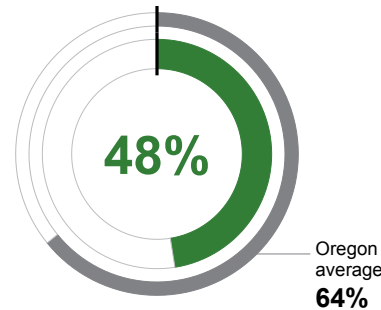
CLASS SIZE

REGULAR ATTENDERS

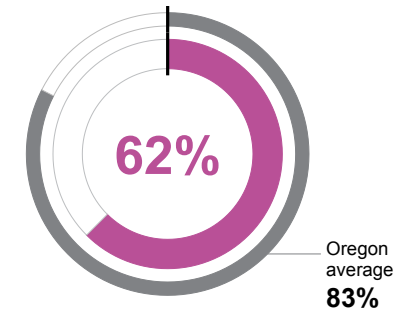
Students who attended more than 90% of their enrolled school days.

ON-TRACK TO GRADUATE

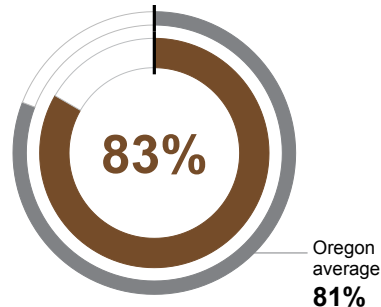
Students earning one-quarter of graduation credits in their 9th grade year.

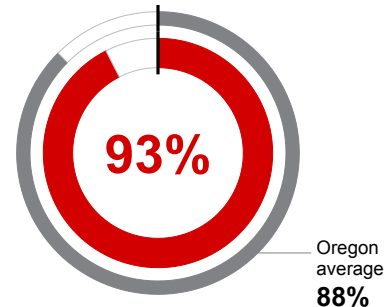
ON-TIME GRADUATION

Students earning a diploma within four years. Cohort includes students who were first-time ninth graders in 2017-18 graduating in 2020-21.



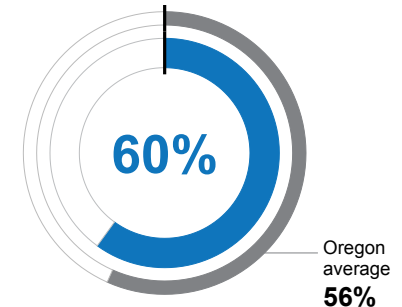
FIVE-YEAR COMPLETION

School Goals

Knappa High School is committed to our vision of all learners prepared to RISE to the opportunities and challenges of the world. Throughout the upcoming school year, staff and students will continue to emphasize the importance of academics along with social-emotional learning. This focus will ensure ninth grade students are on track, graduation rates remain strong, and students are prepared for post high school success. In addition, students are provided opportunities for involvement in community service, the arts, career and technical education activities and athletics.

State Goals

The Oregon Department of Education is partnering with school districts and local communities to ensure a 90% on-time, four year graduation rate by 2025. To progress toward this goal, the state will prioritize efforts to improve attendance, provide a well-rounded education, invest in implementing culturally responsive practices, and promote continuous improvement to close opportunity and achievement gaps for historically and currently underserved students.

Safe & Welcoming Environment

Knappa High School works diligently to ensure that safety of students, staff, and community. We have developed strong partnerships with local law enforcement agencies, fire and rescue, along with mental health service providers. Despite being a secure campus, we encourage community involvement and maintain an "open door" policy. Staff are working to provide opportunities for parent and community involvement through our work on climate and culture.
