The Randolph County Board of Education met in regular session on Monday, June 15, 2009 at 4 p.m. in the Board Room of the Central Office.

Call to Order

B. Coltrane, Chair, called the meeting to order. Board members in attendance were as follows: L. Williams, G. Cook, P. Guthrie, J. Johnson, M. Lambeth, G. Lawson.

Moment of Silence

The Board observed a Moment of Silence before beginning the meeting.

Chair, B. Coltrane, recognized the following Principal Representatives: Terry Burgin, Trindale Elementary, and Kim Leake, New Market Elementary. Members of the press were also welcomed.

Superintendent Andrews made the following announcements:

Approval of Minutes

Christopher Tuft, incoming President for the RCAE, presented support of thanks to the Superintendent and Board of Education for their continued support in decisions regarding the budget.

Lisa Elliott, student at Eastern Randolph High School, presented support of a coach who had been affected by the current budget situation.

CTE Program Highlights and Future Goals

Ann Callicutt, Director of Career-Technical Education, presented information from the Career Technical Programs which consist of Agriculture, Business and , Family and Consumer Science, Health Occupations Education and Trade and Industry. Ms. Callicutt stated that 7,552 students have been served through these various programs. She reported that testing results showed 82.5% proficient. These programs have continually shown steady growth from 2000-2001 to 2008-2009.

Summer Board Retreat

Superintendent Andrews shared that the Board Retreat will be Tuesday, August 18, 2009 from 8:30 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. Agenda items include Title I, Safe Schools, EC, Finance / Budget, Administrations Annual Plans and Athletic Eligibility. Board members were asked to follow up with any thoughts or suggestions they might have for the upcoming work session.

Budget Information Update

Todd Lowe, Finance Officer, stated that for the first time in six to eight months he has seen some improvement in the budget situation. There has been improvement to the sixteen areas of the House proposal that was shared at the special called session on June 3, 2009. Some of them include: the House reinstated 355 million, restored K-3 teachers with no increase in class size, \$939,000 cut has been restored for the at-risk dollars along with the four positions for Instructional Support, and school site administration of the thirty-five months is also back in the budget. Mr. Lowe shared the following as things that are still major concerns: Teacher Assistants not funded for third grade, Non-Instructional, Transportation (saving 1200 miles per day), Central Office, Staff Development, Textbooks, and Technology.

Facility Planning and Construction Update

Marty Trotter, Assistant Superintendent of Operations, stated that the HVAC systems are completed in the high schools. Mr. Trotter stated that he has a completion date for Wheatmore High School of August 5, 2009. The gym floor is being installed and roadwork is continuing.

Wheatmore High School Update

Superintendent Andrews presented a Connect Ed message to the Board to go out to the parents and students of Trinity High School and Wheatmore High School to notify the start of August 21, 2009. Daryl Barnes, Principal of Wheatmore High School, reported that he still has a P.E. slot and a custodial position. Freshman orientation is set for August 10 - 12. Department Chairs and Faculty Senate has been selected. Photos of the site were presented.

Closed Session

J. Johnson made a motion seconded by G. Cook that the Board go into closed session to discuss the terms of an employment contract as provided in North Carolina General Statute 143.318.11(a)(5) and to consider a personnel matter that involves an employee as provided in North Carolina General Statute 143.318.11(a)(6).
