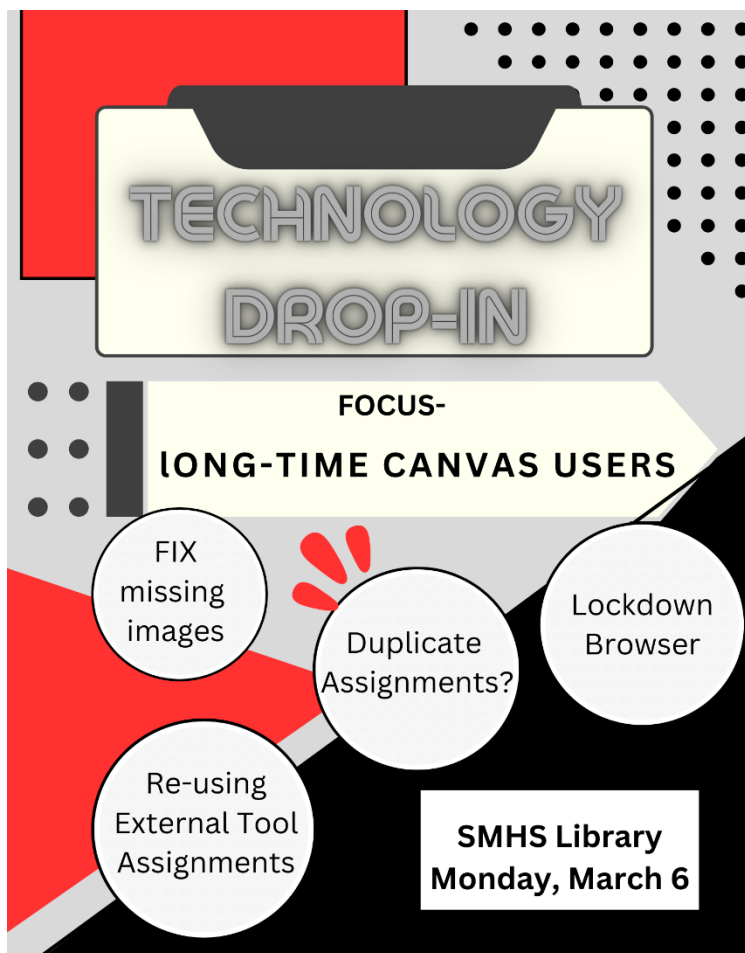
From the Office of the Dean: (Jules Manfreda)
