

#### Phase 1: Preparing the Groundwork

- Removal of trees between the Sand Volleyball Courts and the new building
- Demolition of the old Middle School building
- Regrading the lower field along Catlin Street
- Relocation of power lines behind Gee Price
- Demolition of the Pool House, Football Locker Room, and Pool Apron
- Installation of construction fencing
- · Sitework begins for the new building

#### **Phase 2: New Upper School Building**

- Completion of the Upper School building
- Security systems and fire alarms installed and tested
- IT infrastructure installed and operational
- Landscaping and sidewalks completed around the new building
- Installation of new furnishings and lockers

#### **Phase 3: Enhancing Key Facilities**

- Upfitting the Football Locker Room
- Construction of a new Band Room
