

## 21st Century After School Program Behavior Contract & Information

The 21st Century After Program is NOT a babysitting service.

The purpose of the program is to provide students with strong enrichment activities, as well as, academic focused opportunities designed to complement the students' regular academic program. We are here to help with homework and give some enrichment activities.

In order to provide these services, we will not tolerate behavior problems. We at DMS will be implementing the "3 strikes your out" plan. If your child gets in trouble 3 times they will not be allowed to continue to stay in the program. Each of these "strikes" will be documented and a paper will be sent home with your child for you to sign. Your child will not be allowed to return to the program until the paper is brought back signed (this is for offenses #1 & #2)

By signing this form you are saying that you have read the above policy and aware of the consequences should your child get in trouble. You are also acknowledging that you will be made aware of the offenses and a paper must be signed and returned to the 21st century coordinator (Mrs. Kitty Thomas) before your child is allowed to return.

What is considered a strike? The following are some examples - but NOT limited to the following

1. Refusing to do work
2. Being disrespectful to teachers or other students
3. Being disruptive repeatedly (more than once)
4. Having phone out
5. Being caught on sites (computer) they are not supposed to be on- games, you tube, net flix etc

Fighting or being caught with a vape, etc is an automatic dismissal from the program
