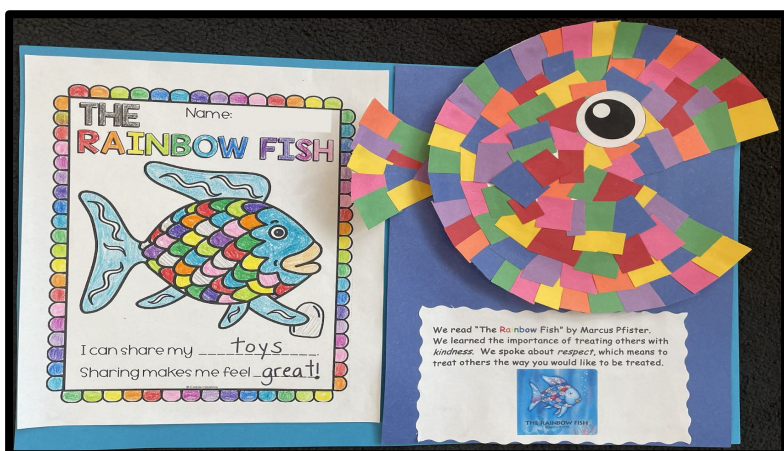
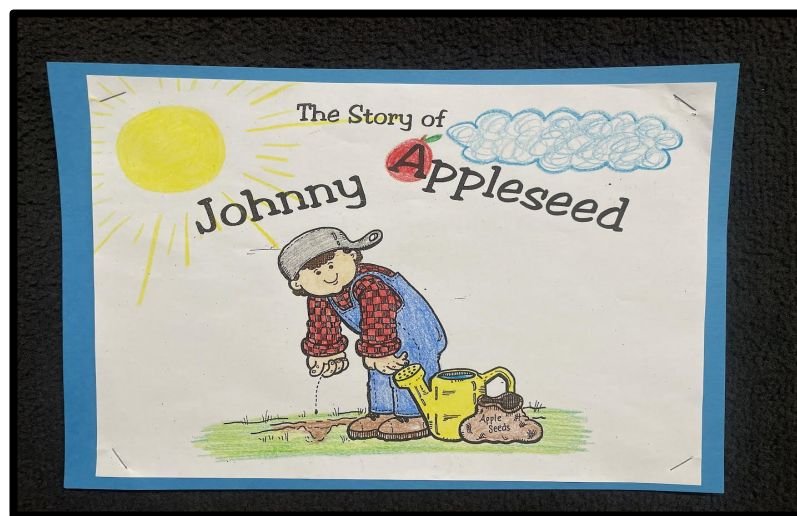
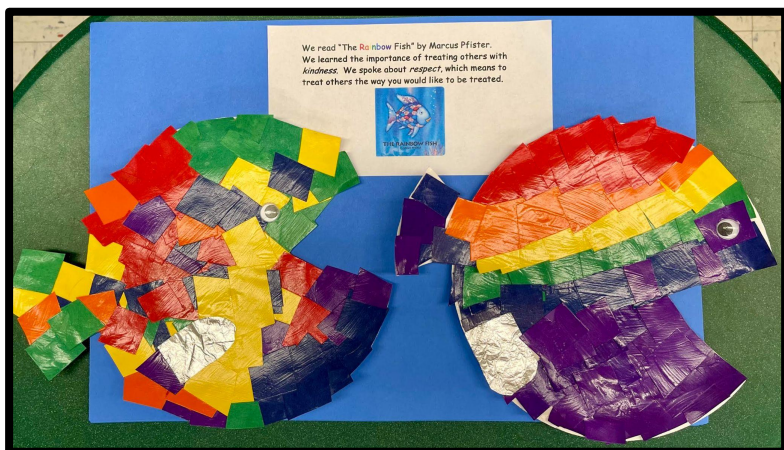




Spotlight on Kindergarten

Dear CRS and LLE Families,

Next week we turn the calendar to the month of October and with that a host of events. One of them, if not the most important, is the [week of respect](#). What a wonderful time to focus on treating everyone with a kind heart. As discussed at the CRS and LLE Back to School Nights, our Guidance Counselors will be speaking to the students about having respect for ourselves. This topic is something that we can often overlook as we are constantly, as is needed, focusing on educating our students with having respect for everyone around us no matter who they are. I ask that during family time (technology free) you speak to your children about this very important topic. Below are some points to discuss:

- **Celebrating their strengths:** Remind your child of the things they do well and how proud you are of them.
- **Encouraging positive self-talk:** Help them notice and replace negative thoughts with kind, truthful ones about themselves.
- **Modeling respect:** Show them how respecting themselves also means setting healthy boundaries and making kind choices.
- **Explaining mistakes (This is Mr. Mazzini's favorite):** Remind them that everyone makes mistakes, but those mistakes don't define who they are.
