Message from Administration:

We have two events coming up during the next couple of weeks that I'd to explain more clearly. Because both of these events are district initiatives, we did not have these events on the year's school calendar until fairly recently.

First, is next week's Orenda site visit. Last night I sent out an email about this upcoming visit (Oct 11-15th). The visit is being conducted at each of our four schools to examine our district's practices/procedures under the lens of equity. This site visit should not have a large effect on our daily classroom routines and will hopefully yield some valuable insights in making our campus as equitable as possible. Details of this event are spelled out above in our "reminders" section, and also in the forementioned email from me yesterday, October 6th.

Another survey event is coming up that might easily be confused with Orenda. This survey is conducted by Panorama. You may remember doing the Panorama survey last year. We were recently given a window of time in which the survey needed to be conducted between Oct. 11th and Oct. 21st. In an effort to NOT conflict with the Orenda visit, we selected October 18th, 2nd pd. for this survey. There will be more details to follow from Mr. Manfreda's office next week, but we wanted to get the dates to you as early as possible. The survey should only take about 15 minutes to complete that day.

I think both of these events can tell us valuable information in our constant effort to improve our school. It is also our intent to execute these events with minimal disruption to daily instruction. Thank you in advance for your help with these projects and I look forward to sharing the results from all this soon. Have a great weekend!
