Hamilton Elementary uses SW-PBS (School-wide Positive Behavior Support). The philosophy of this program is that by rewarding students for positive behavior through Buzz Bucks, positive praise, and rewards, students will begin to build intrinsic motivation to behave in a positive way which will help create a positive learning environment in all areas of the school. We expect students to: BEE Responsible, BEE Respectful, and BEE Self-Controlled and we teach them appropriate behaviors through modeling and lots and lots of practice. Students earn Buzz Bucks for modeling expected behaviors. Students look forward to spending Buzz Bucks at the Buzz Store twice a month.
