Title I Program:

- Southern Local is a Schoolwide Title I District because all of our buildings in our district meet the necessary standards. Title I Programming is implemented at all buildings for all students.
- Title I funding supports Reading Coaches, supplemental classroom materials, and staff professional development.
- The District Leadership Teams meet annually to review district data and progress towards district goals for improvement.
- Building and Teacher Level Teams meet monthly to review building and classroom level data to make recommendations and decisions to impact the learning process and educational environment.

Parent Involvement/Engagement

- Communication to parents includes district social media accounts, district newsletters, classroom dojo, parent teacher conferences twice per year (fall and spring), annual family feedback survey, and family learning activities.
- Parent Teacher Organization (PTO) meets monthly to plan engagement activities for each school year. Contact the Elementary to find out how to become involved.

Student Curriculum and Assessments

- Curriculum Alignment to State Standards occurs annually at the beginning of the school year during teacher professional development.

- Monthly Teacher Based Teams meet to align curriculum and learning processes by grade level and content area.
- MAPS Universal Screening is completed with all students three times per year, fall, winter and spring.
- State Assessments are given at the required intervals and required grade level and subject area.

Special Education

- Special Education students are served in an inclusion model with intervention specialists who co-teach in the classrooms.
- Southern Local partners with our county Educational Service Centers to provide additional support services or support locations when needed.
- Special Education students are included in the Schoolwide Title I programming in both the Elementary and Jr/Sr High School.
