TEAMS Contract Teacher – Math Grades 7-12

Requirements:

- Hold a valid Alabama professional educator certificate or alternate certificate in middle level Math OR secondary Math or computer science;
- Teach full-time approved Math courses in grades 6-12 with the appropriate certificate endorsements; and
- Currently hold or plan to obtain an Advanced Credential from either the National Institute for STEM Education or National Board for Professional Teaching Standards (NBTPS) Certification in Science.

Applications for these positions will be taken and reviewed. These positions will be filled from qualified applicants. No applicant will be employed without a formal application. Applicants already employed by the Dale County Board of Education may submit a letter indicating interest in the positions.
