

#### **ANTONIAN HAIR & GROOMING REQUIREMENTS**

The overarching guideline of the hair and grooming requirements is that students' appearance should be "neat and clean." The final determination on this standard is determined by ACP administration. More complete details can be found in the Student-Parent handbook.

# <u>GIRLS</u>

#### HAIR

- Hairstyles should be neat, clean and moderate at all times
- Extreme, exaggerated or unusual hairstyles are not permitted (i.e. spiked hair, mohawk hair designs, line/pattern designs)
- Any hair accessories must be easily removable
- Only artificial color emulating a natural hair color is permitted
- Subtle highlights are permitted without extreme variation to the student's natural hair color

### **GROOMING/OTHER**

- No visible piercing other than ears
- Spacers or covers cannot be worn to hide piercings
- Jewelry must be in keeping with the conservative nature of the uniform
- Nail polish should be subtle and not of an extreme or distracting color
- Headcoverings (hats, caps, etc.) are not permitted inside the campus during school
- Any tattoos must be covered and not visible

### <u>BOYS</u> HAIR

- Hairstyles should be neat, clean and moderate at all times
- Hair should not extend beyond the collar nor hang over the eyebrows
- Ponytails are not permitted
- Extreme, exaggerated or unusual hairstyles are not permitted (i.e. spiked hair,
- mohawk hair designs, line/pattern designs)
- Sideburns shall not extend lower than the bottom of the earlobe
- Only artificial color emulating a natural hair color is permitted
- Subtle highlights are permitted without extreme variation to the student's natural hair color

## **GROOMING/OTHER**

- Boys are to be clean shaven at all times
- No visible piercings
- Spacers or covers cannot be worn to hide piercings
- Jewelry must be in keeping with the conservative nature of the uniform
- Nail polish, cosmetics or hair accessories are not permitted
- Headcoverings (hats, caps, etc.) are not permitted inside the campus during school
- Any tattoos must be covered and not visible

Final determination on all dress code and grooming standards is up to ACP administration.
