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STUDENT INVOLVEMENT IN DECISION MAKING

The role of the North Country Charter Academy is to create an alternative learning environment for students who have dropped out of school without completing the requirements for high school graduation, or who are deemed to be at risk of not completing their secondary education in a conventional school program. The North Country Charter Academy provides each student with a self-directed curriculum individually tailored to the learning needs of each student, which develops active involvement of students in their education and a spirit of inquiry. The Board of Trustees believes that a student should:

1. Be encouraged to participate in planning classroom activities and in improving courses of studies;
2. Feel free to express, without fear, his/her own opinions, recognizing that every privilege and right has a corresponding responsibility.
3. Be involved in the planning of extended learning opportunities and projects supporting individualized learning plan.
