

ANNUAL NOTICE TO PARENTS REGARDING CHILD IDENTIFICATION, LOCATION, SCREENING & EVALUATION OF STUDENTS IN GRANT COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT #3 UNDER THE INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES EDUCATION IMPROVEMENT ACT (IDEA 2004)

LOCAL RESPONSIBILITY

This notice is to inform parents of the local responsibilities of Grant County School District #3 for child identification, location, and evaluation activities to be conducted throughout the school year, in collaboration with other public agencies and community resources.

Grant County School District #3 must locate and identify children with established or suspected disability conditions, regardless of the severity of the disabilities. Child identification efforts include individuals with disabilities, aged 0 through 21 years, not enrolled in school, as well as those who attend public and private schools, Head Start, State institutions, other child care or treatment facilities.
