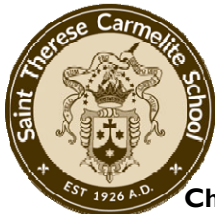

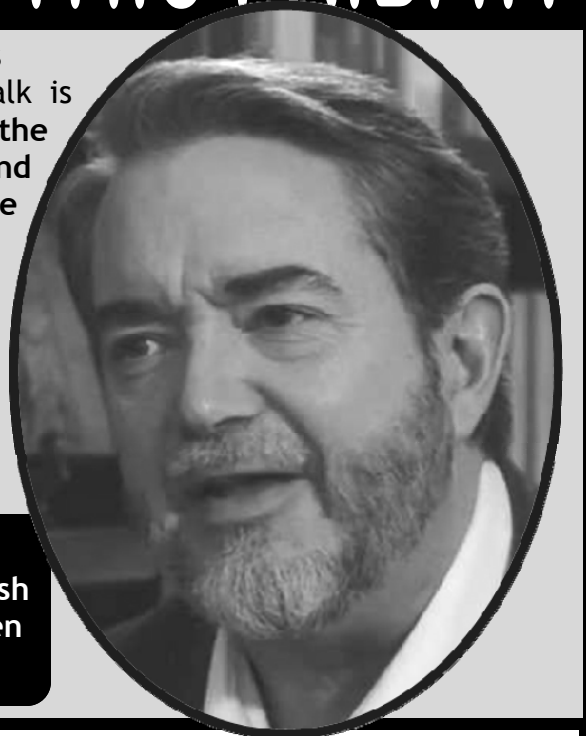
NEW PARISHIONERS: WELCOME TO ST. THERESE! PLEASE REGISTER ONLINE OR IN THE PARISH OFFICE

TELL YOUR SENATOR TO VOTE "NO" ON SB 360

The California Senate voted 30-2 on May 24, 2019, on Senate Bill 360, which would force priests to disclose information concerning the sexual abuse of minors that they hear in confession. The California bishops have been urging lawmakers to strengthen and clarify mandated reporting requirements while maintaining the traditional protections for "penitential communications." But the bill voted out of the Senate today now protects the seal of the confessional—except in cases where a priest is hearing another priest's confession or in cases where a priest is hearing the confession of a co-worker.

In response to this vote, **Archbishop José H. Gomez of Los Angeles issued the following statement:**

"I am deeply disappointed with today's Senate vote on SB 360. I continue to believe we can strengthen mandated reporting laws to protect children's safety while at the same time preserving the sanctity of penitential communications. My brother bishops and I will continue to work with our lawmakers in the Assembly, and I urge Catholics to continue to pray and make your voices heard on this issue, which is so vital to our faith and religious freedom.

PLEASE TELL YOUR STATE SENATOR TO VOTE "NO" ON SB 360

The Bishops of California are urging Catholics to oppose SB 360, which would force priests to disclose what they heard in confession. We know that can NEVER happen! Priests will NEVER disclose what they hear in confession. We ask all Catholics to tell your State Senators that we oppose the government interfering in our right to practice our faith. 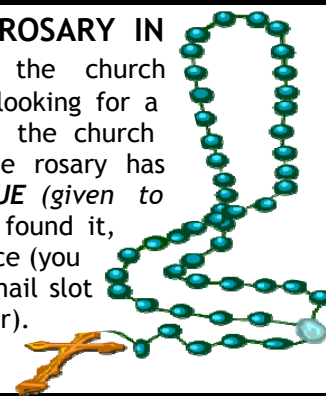
