Practice At Home

Spelling: Dipthongs (oy, oi, ow, ou)

OY and OW are used to spell their sounds at the end of words. OW can be followed by 'l', 'n', or 'er'.

OI and OU are used to spell their sounds in the beginning or middle of words.

Reading: We will continue learning about what a paleontologist does by reading stories about famous paleontologists and their historical discoveries. We will practice answering multiple choice questions to check our reading comprehension.

Math: We will continue to investigate the efficiency of skip counting, and how it can be used to add or subtract.

Science: We will continue to learn about how seeds are dispersed, and how that affects what plants grow in certain habitats.
