KINGSTREE NATIVE HONORED AS A BREAKTHROUGH SCHOLAR AT CLEMSON UNIVERSITY

Ms. Paige McKnight, a freshman majoring in Biological Sciences at Clemson University, was recently announced as a Breakthrough Scholar. Every year, Clemson University selects a group of students to be part of the University's Breakthrough Scholars Program. Breakthrough Scholars are chosen based on their academic excellence, passion for research and discovery, leadership ability, intention to pursue advanced degrees, and potential to make a difference in STEM fields (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math).

The selection process involves reviewing Clemson University undergraduate applications completed by the Early Action deadline, as well as Honors College admission applications completed by the Honors Priority application deadlines. This is followed by interviews and other activities with student finalists during a Scholarship Recruitment Weekend. The Breakthrough Scholars Program (BSP) provides opportunities for scholars to connect with science, engineering, and health professionals and faculty mentors in research labs on and off campus, across the nation, and in other countries. The program also offers a full cost of attendance scholarship to help reduce financial barriers, allowing students to focus on their academics and seek research opportunities during the academic year and over the summer.

The goal of the program is to help scholars develop and utilize their talents to expand their impact in the classroom, the lab, their community, or their future professions. In addition to the benefits offered directly by the BSP, scholars are also members of the Clemson University Honors College.
