Dear Parishioners,

As we celebrate Labor Day weekend, it's a fitting time to reflect on the nature of work and rest, labor and recreation. This isn't just an abstract idea—it speaks to the very core of who we are as human beings.

I recently listened to a podcast about company culture where the speaker mentioned that many in China follow a 6-12 scheduleworking six days a week, 12 hours a day. I found myself wondering what was left for a social life, exercise, religious practices, or even adequate sleep. If someone works 9 am to 9 pm and has a commute, work consumes nearly every waking hour.

In contrast, our 40-hour workweek seems to provide a healthier balance between work and personal life. But for those whose jobs demand more hours—or for those balancing multiple jobs—it's even more critical to care for emotional, psychological, and spiritual needs.

True rest is essential. It's not just about "vegging out" in front of the TV or simply lounging all day. Leisure—in the true sensemeans engaging in activities that restore and re-create us. That's why some people find deep peace in tending a garden (even though it looks like work to others), why others lose themselves in a good book, create a beautiful meal, or are moved by music that refreshes the soul.


In those moments of real rest, we often find clarity, insight, or renewed strength for our work. I hope each of us can identify one or two things that bring that kind of renewal. Labor, prayer, rest, recreation—and repeat—can make for a happier, holier life.

Please also keep our flooring and pew crews in your prayers, that

they may finish in time for our parish festival. I'm hopeful we won't need folding chairs for the Masses on September 13-14, and that our church will be ready to welcome everyone home. With
