

Dear Parishioners,

Happy Mother's Day! I hope that all of our mothers are treated to a day of well-deserved rest and pampering.

Thank you again for your prayers while I was away on retreat. The Retreat Master was Fr. James Kubicki, a Jesuit currently serving on the Rosebud reservation and previously the national director for the Apostleship of Prayer. While nothing he said with earth-shattering, it was excellent. His focus was on the priestly heart as a reflection of the Sacred Heart – an apt image for me to pray with in depth. There were wonderful meal conversations, long walks, and lots of laughter and great personal sharing.

Thank you to all who have given to the St. Eloi sound system. The company installing it is unable to get certain components, so rather than have frustrations that some things work, and others don't, in addition to two separate trips, we are delaying installation until all the components are here – which will be hopefully by mid-July. Financially, we have reached \$20,000 in donations, with an additional amount pledged. Whatever remains will be taking from the Bot Estate. The less we take at this time, the more we have saved for the future, so there is still time to donate to the sound system.

Regarding the heat pumps at St. Edward, we have a verbal yes from the diocese, but need to wait until it is written to formally begin. Thank you to those that already donated to this project.

In just 3 short weeks, we will experience something that few parishes ever will as two native sons will be ordained together. The Ordination is scheduled for May 28, at 10 am at the Church of St. Mary, Sleepy Eye, and all are welcome. Soon-to-be Fr. Tanner will have a Mass of Thanksgiving on the Saturday, May 28, at 7 pm at St. Eloi, and soon-to-be Fr. Josh will offer a Mass of Thanksgiving at St. Edward at 9 am on Sunday, May 29.

I will offer the 5:30 pm Mass at St. Edward, but that will be the only normally scheduled Mass that weekend. All are welcome at the Masses of Thanksgiving. At this time, all three newly ordained will be present at the Masses of Thanksgiving, celebrating together and offering First Priestly Blessings at all the events. Due to the historic nature of this weekend, I am sure you will understand the disruption.
