

Call Out for October 8, 2021

This is Richard Dennis, Superintendent of Elmore County Public Schools.

4 employees and 16 students have reported testing positive this past week which reflects a continued COVID decrease in Elmore County Schools. We continue to encourage everyone to take any necessary precautions, especially those with health issues.

The State Department of Education sets school systems' enrollment on the average daily membership during the 20 days after Labor Day. As of October 4th, Elmore County Public Schools' actual enrollment is 11,315, up from 11,210, and the ADM is 11,284, up from 11,195 last year. If trends continue as they have over the last three years, we expect student enrollment to continue to increase throughout the school year.

Elmore County Schools will be out on Monday and Tuesday next week for our regularly scheduled fall break. Thursday, October 14, all Elmore County 9th, 11th and 12 graders will observe an e-day while all 10th grade students attend on campus to take the Pre-ACT.
