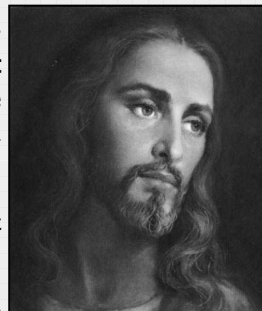

FIRST FRIDAY MASS & ALL-NIGHT VIGIL:

The next First Friday Mass and All-Night Vigil will be this **Friday, December 5**. The celebration will begin with **Mass at 7:30 p.m.**, followed by the all-night vigil, conducted by the Alliance of the Two Hearts. The vigil includes led meditations, the Rosary, and a talk. The celebration conclude with a Benediction service beginning at 5:45 a.m.



ORIGIN: The First Friday Devotion began after Jesus appeared in the late 17th century to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, a French Visitation nun, in a series of apparitions that lasted for a year and a half. He revealed to her His Most Sacred Heart, saying, "Behold this Heart, Which has so loved men that It has spared nothing, even to exhausting and consuming Itself in order to testify to them My love; and in return I receive from the greater number nothing but ingratitude by reason of their irreverence and sacrileges, and by the coldness and contempt which they show in the Sacrament of Love. He made twelve promises for those devoted to His Sacred Heart. The promises He made are: 1) *I will give them all of the graces necessary for their state of life;* 2) *I will establish peace in their houses;* 3) *I will comfort them in all their afflictions;* 4) *I will be their strength during life and above all during death;* 5) *I will bestow a large blessing upon all their undertakings;* 6) *Sinners shall find in My Heart the source and the infinite ocean of mercy;* 7) *Tepid souls shall grow fervent;* 8) *Fervent souls shall quickly mount to high perfection;* 9) *I will bless every place where a picture of my heart shall be set up and honored;* 10) *I will give to priests the gift of touching the most hardened hearts;* 11) *Those who shall promote this devotion shall have their names written in My Heart, never to be blotted out;* 12) *I promise you in the excessive mercy of My Heart that My all-powerful love will grant to all those who receive Holy Communion on the First Friday in nine consecutive months the grace of final penitence; they shall not die in My disgrace nor without receiving their sacraments; My Divine Heart shall be their safe refuge in this last moment.* (Note: If the person is not in the state of grace, he or she would need to first receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation.)

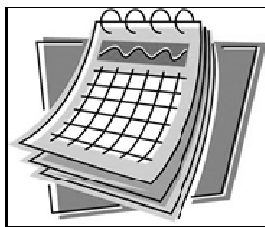
LEGION OF MARY DISCUSSION GROUP:

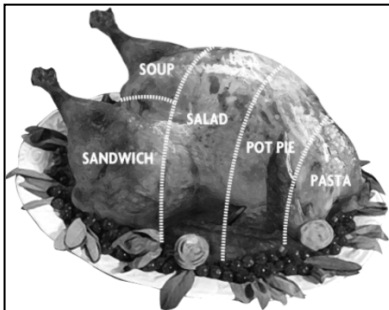

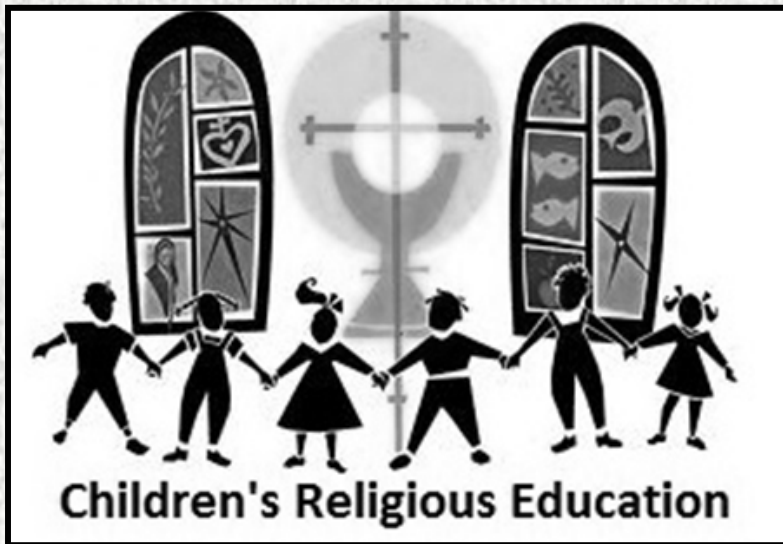

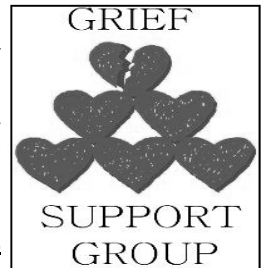


Your child will then be baptized on a Saturday (next open Baptisms are December 20 and January 24—both dates at Noon).

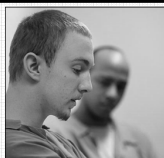
