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**Purpose:**

You are invited to submit a proposal for providing RUS DLT Equipment, Installation & Training Services for the Benton County School District. The Benton County School District wishes to establish a three-year contract with a qualified vendor who offers the desired services at competitive prices and who meets all bid qualifications. Competitive pricing will be a major part of the evaluation and all vendors will not necessarily be accepted. **Submission deadline is referenced multiple times within this document. Late responses will NOT be accepted.**

Each of the sites in this project will receive interactive distance communications (telemedicine and learning) technologies. Sites will receive a combination of equipment packages based on specific identified needs of group professional development sessions, single student remote mental health visits, and class instruction. Individual components of the packages include carts, video codecs, HD cameras, microphones, robust speaker systems, interactive displays, and/or laptops. The equipment provides a live and interactive environment of accomplishing project goals, ensuring interoperability amongst sites as well as with other content providers. A variety of technologies were reviewed as the project was developed. Discussions with other Mississippi school districts in addition to the partners' prior experiences provided the reference points needed to select the technologies for our budget.

**General Requirements:**

**I. General Conditions**

The following are the minimal General Conditions for the work to be performed in the school district ("Client") as outlined in the Detailed Specifications.

**1. Location of Sites:**

The location of the work is on property owned by "The Client".

**2. Scope of Work:**

It is understood that, except as otherwise specifically stated in this RFP, "The Vendor" shall provide and pay for all materials, labor, tools, equipment, transportation, temporary construction of every nature and

all other services and facilities of every nature whatsoever, necessary to execute, complete and deliver the work within the specified time. Licenses necessary for the execution of the work shall be secured and paid for by "The Vendor".

Any work necessary to be performed after regular working hours, on weekends or legal holidays, shall be performed without additional expense to "The Client", unless the weekend or holiday work is the result of a delay created by "The Client".

All data sheets and catalogs or other materials which are subject to review and action by "The Client" shall be submitted in the original and not less than three (3) copies in paper and electronic format, preferably on USB media or available via any cloud service. No log-in should be required for cloud-shared documents. Prior to start of work, "The Vendor" should submit a proposed layout of any work to be performed.

### **3. Protection in General:**

"The Vendor" shall protect all buildings, furniture, equipment, personal items, trees, shrubs, lawns and all landscaping on school property from damage. Any damaged property shall be repaired or replaced at "The Vendor's" expense. Labor shall include all restoration (leveling, sodding) of grounds broken up during the installation of this network.

### **4. Change in Contract:**

"The Client" will not be responsible for any change in the work involving extra costs unless approval in writing is furnished by an authorized representative of "The Client" before such work is begun.

### **5. Existing Conditions:**

"The Vendor", in undertaking the work under this contract and before issuing a bid response, is assumed to have visited the premises and to have taken into consideration all conditions which might affect this work. No consideration will be given to any claims based on a lack of knowledge of existing conditions. A site survey of the premises for existing conditions and equipment will be set by "The Client" and attendance is required for any vendor submitting a bid response.

### **6. Insurance:**

Within ten (10) days after notification of award, "The Vendor" shall furnish to "The Client" a Certificate of Insurance showing compliance within the following limitations:

- a) "The Vendor" agrees to comply with the provisions of Worker's Compensation Laws of the State of Mississippi.
- b) It shall be stated on every policy or Certificate of Insurance, as the case may be, that "The insurance company agrees that the policy shall not be canceled, changed, or allowed to lapse until ten (10) days after "The Client" has received written notice as evidenced by the return receipt of registered mail, and it is agreed further that as to lapsing, such notice will not be valid if mailed more than fifteen (15) days prior to the expiration date shown on the policy"
- c) "The Vendor" shall maintain other insurance (with the limits shown below) that shall protect "The Vendor" and "The Client" from any claim for property damage or personal injury, including death, which may arise out of operations under this contract, and "The Vendor" shall furnish "The Client" with certificates and policies of such insurance as shown below

Below is a list of the insurance coverage that must be procured by "The Vendor" at their own expense. "The Vendor" agrees to follow instructions indicated in each case:

Vendor's Public Liability Insurance:

- Personal injury, including death, limits of \$1,000,000.00 for each person and \$1,000,000.00 for each accident
- Property Damage limits of \$100,000.00 for each accident and \$500,000.00 for the aggregate

## 7. Workmanship

All work shall be performed in a professional manner. Personnel from “The Client” may observe the work procedures and workmanship of “The Vendor”, but such observation will not relieve “The Vendor” from any responsibility of performance or constitute acceptance of the work performed.

## 8. Warranty

“The Vendor” shall furnish a written warranty that describes the services proposed under these specifications. It is understood that “The Vendor” is not responsible for the warranty/function of existing equipment already installed at the schools. However, limited troubleshooting of existing equipment or cabling will be provided by “The Vendor” free of charge to determine if the existing equipment or cabling can be reutilized. “The Vendor” must also show proof that their employee(s) are certified to install the proposed cabling components and electronic equipment, as assurance that a warranty can be provided.

## 9. General Finance and Payment Information

“The Vendor” will provide a binding contract or service agreement to “The Client”. After notification of award from “The Client”, “The Vendor” will receive a purchase order for the products and services for which “The Vendor” will be responsible as a result of this RFP. This purchase order will show the total amount of the project or the agreed upon amount due for a completed portion of the project. The amount for which “The Client” is responsible must be approved for reimbursement from the USDA, minus the local match. This purchase order will constitute a contingent contract between “The Client” and “The Vendor”. The purchase order will become a legal binding contract between “The Client” and “The Vendor”. The purchase order will be the document used to determine the status of the contract and will determine the amount of payment by “The Client”.

## 10. Application for Payment

All applications (invoices) for payment shall be submitted to “The Client”.

## 11. Proposal Submittal:

Proposals and supporting documentation must be hand-delivered or sent by USPS, parcel service, or courier. Proposals must be in a SEALED envelope clearly marked Bid 012024

\*\*\*Please reference page 1 (Title page), page 2 (first paragraph), and page 3 (General Directions) for specific information regarding ALL requirements for submission and specifications for labeling submissions.

**Do Not Fax Proposals.** Faxed proposals, unsealed proposals, and improperly labeled proposals will not be accepted. Proposals will be received at the Benton County School District Central Office Monday through Friday from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM at the address shown above until 3:00 PM on February 16, 2024 (bid proposal deadline).

Additional reminder: The Benton County School District will not be responsible for any proposals that

are late due to shipping/carrier delivery errors, specified address errors, or any other factor deemed outside the control of the Benton County School District.

## **12. Withdrawal of Proposal**

A proposal cannot be withdrawn after it is filed, unless “The Vendor” makes a request in writing to the Benton County School District and such request is submitted prior to the designated opening of submitted proposals.

## **13. “The Vendor’s” Qualifications must be presented to “The Client” as a condition of the Vendor/District Contract**

All requested documents, i.e., business licenses, insurance documents, video, video conferencing and infrastructure technical certifications as well as reseller certifications from all manufacturer’s products proposed. Certifications must be relevant to the installation project and the products within the project.

## **14. Stored Materials**

Any materials stored on job site shall be “The Vendor’s” responsibility and must not impede the normal operations of the facility.

## **15. Product Specifications**

Complete specification details for all products being proposed must be provided as part of the RFP response package (proposal) for purposes of validating proposed equipment and services will meet the intent of the project and the same meets the minimum technical standards requested.

## **16. Accident Prevention**

Precautions shall be exercised at all times for the protection of persons (including employees) and property and hazardous conditions shall be guarded against or eliminated.

## **17. Indemnification**

“The Vendor” agrees to hold “The Client” harmless and to indemnify “The Client” for every expense, liability or payment arising out of or through injury (including death) to any person or persons or damage to property (regardless of whom the owner may be of the property) of any place in which work is located arising out of or suffered through any act or omission of “The Vendor” or Subcontractor.

## **18. “The Vendors’ Representative**

“The Client” reserves the right, with sole discretion, to refuse to allow any representative of “The Vendor” to service the contract in any manner. In this event, “The Vendor” shall furnish another representative that is acceptable to “The Client”. Examples of reasons for refusing to allow a vendor representative to service the contract include, but are not limited to:

- Use of profanity or abusive language around any school personnel or students
- Use of tobacco products in areas labeled as “Tobacco Free”
- Unclean or unkempt appearance
- Intoxication or obvious drug use
- Threatening behavior towards any school personnel or students
- Intentional or careless acts of workmanship which impede the satisfactory completion of the project as interpreted by “The Client”

## 19. “The Client” Regulations

“The Vendor” and his representatives shall follow all applicable school district regulations while on “The Client” property, including the no smoking, no weapons, and drug free policies. No work shall interfere with school activities or environment unless the Principal or person in charge gives permission. All Vendor personnel shall be easily identified by the use of identification badges and uniforms or shirts with “The Vendor’s” logo clearly visible. “The Vendor” representatives, including installation teams, will follow proper visitor sign-in procedures at all locations and will notify the highest-ranking organization representative (Principal, designee, etc.) of their presence on the campus.

## 20. Governing Law

All RFPs and related documents submitted to the Benton County School District and “The Client” by “The Vendor” are governed under the laws of the State of Mississippi.

## 21. School District reserves the right to:

- Give full and proper consideration to the service, reputation, product knowledge, and experience of all companies presenting proposals, and to disqualify any such Vendor it deems unqualified to provide the services requested
- Reject any and all proposals if deemed necessary
- Accept any alternative proposal believed to be in the best interest of “The Client”
- Waive any formality in the bid submission
- Reject any proposal by a vendor who does not follow the instructions outlined in the RFP. The following are examples and are NOT an exhaustive list. Thoroughly read the RFP to ensure all instructions and proposal requests are followed: failure to submit required certifications, failure to submit product specifications to measure equivalency, failure to attend mandatory site visit.

\*\*The “Client” has the responsibility of reviewing all bids and selecting a Vendor. No other entities will be involved in the selection process.

## 22. Price Quotations

Price quotations are to include the furnishing of all materials, equipment, maintenance, shipping costs, delivery, installation, drawings and the provision of all labor and services necessary or proper for the completion of the work as may be otherwise expressly provided in the Contract Documents. “The Client” will not be liable for any costs beyond those proposed herein and awards. Please be advised that public schools are typically exempt from federal, state, and local taxes. Do not include taxes.

In case of discrepancy in computed total proposal prices, the **unit** price shall govern and the total price shall be revised accordingly. Please ensure unit prices are correct.

## 23. Terms of Payment

All terms of payment are to be in accordance with federal and state statutes after the project has been approved and inspected as a complete job by “The Client”.

## 24. Turnkey Solution

All proposals are to provide a turnkey solution for installation of Distance Learning Equipment. “The Client” agrees to certify acceptance location by location to establish an incremental performance baseline. However, the final system installation shall provide the capabilities specified in Section II, Detailed Specifications. Vendor agrees to provide “Net 60” terms for payment. This will allow us to file for reimbursement from the USDA.

## 25. Longevity of Price Quotation

Any prices quoted in the bid responses will remain in effect until 90 days after the governing body acting for “The Client” (Board of Education, Supt’s office, etc.) has issued a proposal acceptance letter to the chosen vendor. In addition, the 90-day price guarantee cannot be retracted prior to the acceptance of the official award notification letter by “The Client” and issued from the USDA. Thus, the 90-day pricing guarantee should be in effect until 90 days post USDA written notification to “The Client”.

## II. Reminders and Detailed Equipment Specifications

1. Site visit must be performed by “The Vendor” to develop a clear understanding of the site requirements. Visitation times are entirely at the discretion of “The Client”
2. Must be certified to provide ALL the products and services specified in the bid
3. Must be able to integrate the use of ALL the products and provide interoperability training for ALL brands of equipment included in the RFP
4. Must use NEW original manufacturer equipment for all items. All bid items must use the manufacturer’s part number when bidding a specified brand/manufacturer. “The Client” reserves the right to specify a manufacturer and model as a part of the RFP, but must also accept and consider all equivalent responses. If bidding an equivalent brand as opposed to a request within the RFP, bidder must provide proof the products bid are, in fact, equivalent; including all the products and services. When submitting an equivalent alternative to a specified product, “The Vendor” must provide specification documents from the manufacturer, as well as a self-produced document used for “cross-checks” at a glance for the “requested” equipment/service specifications as compared to the “equivalent” equipment/service response
5. Vendor is totally responsible for the integration of all the products to work cohesively, and must provide any miscellaneous parts and services to provide a fully operational system
6. Training must be provided by an employee that has K12 teaching/admin experience
7. Minimum of three (3) K12 USDA RUS/DLT Grant project reference contacts
8. Minimum of ten (10) completed RUS/DLT projects during previous award cycles
9. Minimum of five (5) years of experience implementing RUS/DLT projects
10. Reseller ISO 9001 Certification required
11. Vendor offices must reside within a reasonable geographic area to the Benton County School District i.e., within the state or an adjoining state

### **III. “The Client’s” Responsibilities**

#### **1. Access for Installation**

- “The Client” will, during the progress of the installation, allow “The Vendor” and its employees access to the premises and facilities at all reasonable hours or at such hours as “The Client” representative and “The Vendor” agree upon
- “The Client” will provide access to existing conduit or the placement of new conduit if necessary to all work locations, floors, buildings, etc., to support the media installation and provide Vendor access to these adjacent areas where and when required

#### **2. Heating/Cooling**

- Provide heat or cooling when required and general illumination in rooms where work is to be performed by “The Vendor”

#### **3. Inspections**

- Promptly make inspections when notified by “The Vendor” that the equipment or any part thereof, is ready for installation
4. **Electrical**
    - “The Client” sites will provide all electrical needs
  5. **Delay in Work**
    - It is understood that “The Vendor” will not be held accountable for any delays caused by “The Client”
  6. **Refuse, boxes, cleaning**
    - “The Client” is responsible for providing a location for disposal of cardboard boxes and packing materials. However, it is understood “The Vendor” will leave all areas of access free of debris and left in the same condition it was found (i.e. furniture placement is same with dirt, debris, ceiling tiles, tools, etc. removed and/or left in the original condition)

#### **IV. “The Vendor’s” Responsibilities**

1. **Provision**
  - “The Vendor” must provide all supervision, tools, equipment, hardware and wiring materials as specified; transportation, erection, construction, unloading, inspecting, and keeping inventory as specified in attached contract documents
  - Whenever in the Contract, the terms "provide, furnish, supply, install, etc.", can be interpreted as requiring “The Vendor” both to furnish and/or install materials, unless specific provisioning/installation of the materials by “The Client” is denoted
2. **Firewalls**
  - Provide for the installation of all conduits and sleeves through firewalls and application of fire-stopping materials as required to meet codes
3. **Ceiling Tiles**
  - Provide for the removal and reinstallation of all ceiling tiles as needed. Any broken ceiling tiles will be replaced with equal or better quality of the damaged ceiling tiles
4. **Identification**
  - “The Vendor” will identify to "The Client" any work necessitating cutting into or through any part of the building structure such as girders, beams, concrete, tile floors or partition ceilings
5. **Permits**
  - “The Vendor” shall obtain all necessary county, municipal, and/or state work/building permit
6. **Damage**

- “The Vendor” will be responsible for repairs of damage to the building, roads, equipment, existing cable, or property. “The Vendor” will promptly report to a representative of “The Client” any such damage to the building, roads, equipment, existing cable, or property that may occur while performing work in the facilities

#### **7. Installation**

- Install any wire, cable, and/or associated hardware in accordance with the manufacturer’s specifications. All cabling and equipment shall be sufficiently labeled such that the equipment designation or purpose, interconnections and cabling endpoints can be easily determined. All labeling shall correspond with the solution drawings provided by the selected vendor

#### **8. Test and Inspections**

- After installation has been completed, conduct tests and inspections in the presence of a technical representative designated by “The Client”. This assures “The Client” that requirements for the installation are met

#### **9. Completions Notification**

- Promptly notify “The Client” designated contact of completion of this proposed project

#### **10. Defects**

- “The Vendor” will promptly correct all defects for which “The Vendor” is responsible

#### **11. “The Client” Contact**

- “The Vendor” must coordinate all work with “The Client” designated contact

#### **12. Cleanup**

- Upon completion of the work each day, “The Vendor” must remove all tools, equipment, rubbish and debris from the premises and must leave the premises clean and neat and in the same condition as it was found. “The Client” is responsible for providing a location for disposal of cardboard boxes and packing materials. However, it is understood “The Vendor” will leave all areas of access free of debris and left in the same condition it was found (i.e. furniture placement is same with dirt, debris, ceiling tiles, tools, etc. removed and/or left in the original condition)

#### **13. Subcontractors**

- “The Vendor’s” may not use subcontractors to perform work without prior approval by “The Client”

#### **14. Testing**

- “The Vendor” will properly test all installed equipment to ensure it is operating as designated in the project.

#### **15. Warranty**

- This system is to be provided as a turnkey solution and requires “The Vendor” to provide

complete maintenance and warranty the system in full

#### **16. Codes and Ordinances**

- All work shall conform to the latest edition of the National Electrical Code, the Building Code, and all local codes and ordinances, as applicable. ANSI/TIA/EIA-568-A and ANSI/EIA/TIA-569 shall be adhered to during all installation activities
- Should conflicts exist with the foregoing, the authority having jurisdiction for enforcement will have responsibility for making interpretation

#### **17. Safety**

- “The Vendor” shall take the necessary precautions and bear the sole responsibility for the safety of the methods employed in performing the work.
- “The Vendor” shall at all times comply with the regulations set forth by federal, state, and local laws; rules; and regulations concerning “OSHA”, and all applicable state labor laws, regulations, and standards.
- “The Vendor” shall indemnify and hold harmless “The Client” from and against all liabilities, suits, damages, costs, and expenses (including attorney’s fees and court costs) that may be imposed on “The Client” due to “The Vendor”, subcontractor, or supplier’s failure to comply with the regulations stated herein

#### **18. Patents and Royalties**

- “The Vendor”, without exception, shall indemnify and hold harmless “The Client” and its employees from any liability of any nature or kind, including costs and expenses for or on account of any trademarked, copyrighted, patented, or non-patented invention, process, or article manufactured or used in the performance of the Contract, including its use by “The Client”
- If “The Vendor” or subcontractor uses any design, device, or material covered by letters, patent, trademark, or copyright, it is mutually understood and agreed without exception that the proposal prices shall include all royalties or cost arising from the use of such design, device, or materials in any way involved in the work
- 

#### **19. Indemnification**

- “The Vendor” shall indemnify and hold harmless “The Client”, its agents and employees from or on account of any injuries or damages, received or sustained by any person or persons during or on account of any operation connected with this Contract; or by consequence or any negligence (excluding negligence by “The Client” its agents, or employees) in connection with the same; or by use of any improper material or by or on account of any act or omission of said Vendor or its subcontractors, agents, servants, or employees. “The Vendor” further agrees to indemnify and hold harmless “The Client”, its agents or employees, against claims or liability arising from or based upon the violation of any federal, state, county, city, or other applicable laws, bylaws, ordinances, or regulations by “The Vendor”, its agents, associates, or employee
- The indemnification provided above shall obligate “The Vendor” to defend at its own expense or to provide for such defense, at “The Client’s” option, of any and all claims of liability and all suits and actions of every name and description that may be brought against “The Client”, which may result from the operations and activities under this Contract whether the installation operations be performed by “The Vendor”, subcontractor, or by anyone directly or indirectly employed by either
- The award of this Contract to “The Vendor” shall obligate “The Vendor” to comply with the foregoing indemnity provision; however, the collateral obligation of insuring this indemnity must be complied with as set forth
