STUDENT AUTOMOBILE USE

Both North Country Charter Academy sites have public parking lots that are shared by other businesses. All students are expected to behave responsibly when driving themselves. Any student caught driving in a reckless manner will be referred to the Principal to determine whether or not the student will be allowed to transport themselves and a written report will be submitted to local police authority

Students are allowed to bring motor vehicles to the Charter Academy and to the school in which he/she is scheduled for vocational classes. All vehicles must be registered with the North Country Charter Academy main office which will require all students to submit a copy of a valid driver's license, proof of insurance, NCCA student vehicle registration form and release of liability form.
