The 2024-2025 FAFSA is now available. Get prepared by gathering the necessary information.

What you need to file the 2024-2025 FAFSA

CREATE YOUR FEDERAL STUDENT AID ACCOUNT NOW!

- When you create your account, you'll set up your FSA ID. Your FSA ID is the username and password you'll use to access all Federal Student Aid websites, including StudentAid.gov (where you'll file your FAFSA). It takes about 10 minutes to create an account and set up an FSA ID. Your FSA ID must be matched with the Social Security Administration before you can use it to access the FAFSA (which typically takes 3-5 days). If you're a dependent student, your parent(s) will need to create their own account and set up an FSA ID so they can access and sign their section of the FAFSA.
- To create an account and set up an FSA ID, go to StudentAid.gov and click on "Create Account." Keep track of your FSA ID information using a Student FSA ID Worksheet. Your parent(s) can keep track of their FSA ID information with a Parent FSA ID Worksheet.

Students are considered dependent and required to provide parent information unless they can answer YES to one of the following questions:

Were you born before January 1, 2001?		Do you have children or dependents who will receive more than half of the
As of today, are you married?		support from you between July 1, 2024 and June 30, 2025?
At the beginning of the 2024-2025 school year, will you be working on a graduate program?		At any time since you turned 13, were both your parents deceased, were you in foster care or were you a dependent or ward of the court?
Are you currently serving on active duty in the U.S. Armed Forces for purposes other than training, or are you a veteran of the U.S. Armed		As determined by a court in your state of legal residence, are you or were you an emancipated minor or in a legal guardianship?
Forces?		At any time on or after July 1, 2023, were you homeless or at risk of being homeless?
