Project Design

All district schools have agreed to continue implementation of the Chris Hixon, Coach Aaron Feis, and Coach Scott Beigel Guardian Program, established in s. 30.15, Florida Statutes and per s 1006.12(3), Florida Statutes. There are no charter schools in Liberty County at this time.

Identification of measurable screening and training goals for participants who elect to participate in the Chris Hixon, Coach Aaron Feis, and Coach Scott Beigel Guardian Program Grant will follow Chris Hixon, Coach Aaron Feis, and Coach Scott Beigel Guardian Program Grant suggested guidelines and current LCSO processes.
