PGHS/WHS Release of Claims Agreement

G. Cook made a motion seconded by G. Mason to approve the proposed settlement agreement dated February 21, 2011, between DeVere Construction Company, Inc. and the Board which is intended to resolve only the claims specified in the agreement that arose out of the construction of Providence Grove High School and Wheatmore High School by authorizing the payment of a portion of the contract balance at both schools with the Board permanently retaining \$84,446 from the Providence contract and \$45,000 from the Wheatmore contract.
