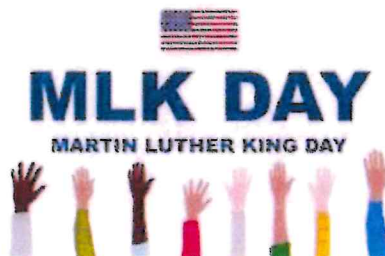




Notes from the Principal

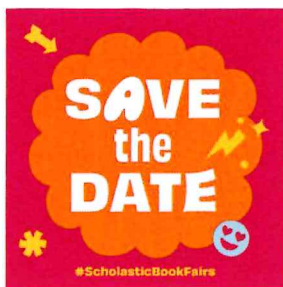

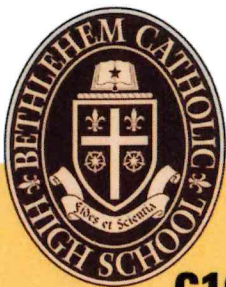
