4. New Business

- ❖ Recommendation for approval of yearly School Safety Plan – Dan Mather Plant Manager shared
 - He has been with the district 6 years. Current safety concerns include no SROs at the sites except for RHS who has a sheriff. In past few years, PV has added building labels, classroom numbers, added 7 electronic gates, and installed an automatic ALICE gate that opens all 7 gates at once. Only Admin and specific personnel have access to this feature. The sewing class is in process of creating accordion style window covers for each classroom door and project is 80% complete. The safety plan is disaster coordination directions which lists all basic emergencies. It is a living document. Staff came up with the idea to label classroom numbers inside the room above every door.
 - There are 83 cameras on campus, and we should have 100 cameras by the end of the year
 - There are 3 metal fireproof V-BOX's (Violence response boxes) that are kept in various locations. V-Boxes include Master keys, Master Lists, Teacher Emergency Information, and a "V" is on the roof so emergency personnel know where to find important information
 - A copy of the Safety Plan is kept in Mrs. Herrera's office.

 - PVHS received highest dollar amount
 - Hancock Promise Date – Class of 2021
 - 458 students completed the Hancock Promise application

 - Race to submit FAFSA – 60% of PVHS students have submitted
 - FAFSA California Leaderboard as of 2/22/22
 - Last year PVHS ranked in the top 10, This year PVHS is number 5, 3rd year in the top 10 of California
