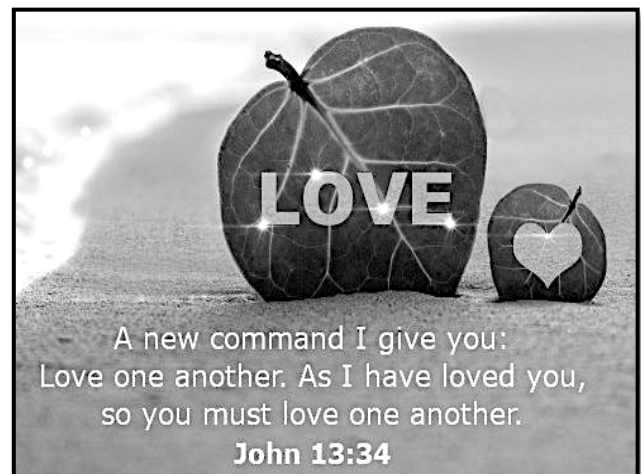
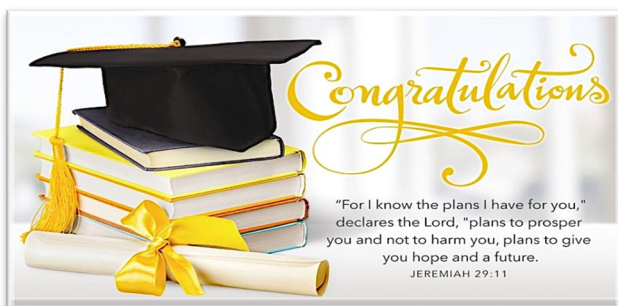
Dear Parishioners,

With the end of the school year, much of the activity of parish life slows down. I am looking forward to the slower pace again of a 'normal' summer. I hope that we all can carve out a little more time for rest and prayer.
