**Goal 1: Rhea County Schools will increase the ELA proficiency rate for 3<sup>rd</sup> grade students. By 2030, we will increase the ELA proficiency in Grade 3 ELA to 70%.**

**Action Steps:**

1. Consistent unit and lesson pre implementation of ELA HQIM
2. High dosage, low ratio tutoring for retained or struggling students with highly qualified teachers.
3. RTI2
4. Summer Programming with highly qualified teachers.

**Programs and Funding:**

1. HQIM- Funds will be used to buy materials to accompany the textbook adoption.
2. Tutoring- Funds will be used to purchase IXL, 27 tutors (teachers), Accelerated Reader, Reading Eggs, Scholastic.
3. RTI2- Funds will be used to purchase the SPIRE program and EasyCBM.
4. Summer- Funds will be used to fund teachers (approx 12 teachers) and transportation for students.

**Goal 2: Rhea County Schools will increase the ELA proficiency rate of all students, in all grade bands for ELA. By 2030, we will increase the ELA proficiency in grades 3-8 from 38.1% to 48.1% and grades the ELA proficiency in grades 9-12 from 41% to 51%.**

**Action Steps:**

1. Consistent unit and lesson pre implementation of ELA HQIM
2. High dosage, low ratio tutoring for retained or struggling students with highly qualified teachers.
3. RTI2
4. Summer Programming with highly qualified teachers.

**Programs and Funding:**

1. HQIM- Funds will be used to buy materials to accompany the textbook adoption.
2. Tutoring- Funds will be used to purchase IXL, tutors (teachers), Accelerated Reader, Reading Eggs, Scholastic.
3. RTI2- Funds will be used to purchase the SPIRE program for grades K-5, iReady for grades 6-8, and both the Achieve 3000 and STAR purchased for grades 9-12. EasyCBM will be purchased for all grades.
4. Summer- Funds will be used to fund teachers (approx 8 teachers) and transportation for students.

**Goal 3: Rhea County Schools will increase the Math proficiency rate of all students, in all grade bands for Math. By 2030, we will increase the Math proficiency in grades 3-8 from 45.3% to 55.3% and grades the Math proficiency in grades 9-12 from 28% to 38%.**

**Action Steps:**

1. Consistent unit and lesson pre implementation of ELA HQIM
2. High dosage, low ratio tutoring for retained or struggling students with highly qualified teachers.
3. RTI2
4. Summer Programming with highly qualified teachers.

**Programs and Funding**

1. HQIM- Funds will be used to buy materials to accompany the textbook adoption.
2. Tutoring- Funds will be used to purchase IXL, 27 tutors (teachers), Math Thieves,
3. RTI2- Funds will be used to purchase EasyCBM for all grades, the SPIRE program for grades K-5, SAVVAS for grades 6-8, and both Achieve 3000 and STAR for grades 9-12.
4. Summer- Funds will be used to fund teachers (approx 4 teachers) and transportation for students.
