## IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT KINDERGARTEN

Getting ready for kindergarten is an exciting time but can feel overwhelming for parents! We have put together a list of important information that will be helpful as you plan for next school year!



**1**. Your child's attendance is very important. School starts promptly at 8:30. School is dismissed at 3:30. Vacations do not count as excused absences.

2. Kindergarten students do NOT take naps.

**3**. Kindergarten does have snack time daily, but snacks are not provided. If you would like your child to have a snack you must send it from home. Most students bring a small snack such as crackers or fruit snacks and a juice box or water.

**4**. School behavior is very important. We use a schoolwide classroom management system called Class Dojo. Your child's teacher will send home information at the beginning of the year explaining Class Dojo and how you can access your child's daily behavior.

**5**. Independence is very important for kindergarten! Students will learn how to be independent throughout the school year. This is something that you can practice at home over the summer! PreK students should be able to dress themselves, independently put on shoes, socks, and coats as well as open most snacks and drinks. PreK students should be able to handle all bathroom business independently before starting school. If your child can not do these things independently, please work on this over the summer before your child begins kindergarten. Also, students should be able to correctly communicate needs and wants before beginning school. For example, "I need to go the bathroom", "I need help", etc....

**6**. Your child will have a very busy school day! We have many different components to our school day. Every day your child will participate in the following:

- Reading
- · Writing
- · Phonics
- Math/number corner/number talk/math tubs
- · Science
- · Social Studies
- · Recess
- Specials (PE, Art, Or Music)
