

Protect Your School Issued Device

Once again, Franklin County Community Schools have partnered with Worth Ave Group to offer affordable insurance for student mobile devices. All students in grades K-1 will be issued an iPad and all students in grades 2-12 will be issued a Chromebook. Accidents do happen and when they do, it can be costly. A cracked iPad screen alone can cost \$100 to repair. However, if you purchase coverage the cost would be \$0.
