We are finishing up our unit for ELA. Students are learning how to put a finger space in between words when they write and draw a picture that matches the phrase. Students are also learning about fiction stories. After we read a story, students identify if the story is fiction and can state how they know the story is fiction.

We are also finishing up our chapter learning about the number 10. Students can find number pairs that make ten, compare numbers to identify what number is greater and what number is lesser. This week we studied conifers, or evergreen trees. We researched their features and dissected Douglas fir cones. One of our students discovered a critter I had never seen before, so of course we had to investigate further. We found out the critter was a pseudoscorpion!

We also kicked off the first day of December by putting up our class Christmas tree! Students will be making their own ornaments for our little conifer throughout December as an early finisher task.

In math, first graders will be wrapping up Chapter 5 on addition and subtraction relationships. Second graders are working through Chapter 4 on 2-digit addition. As you read aloud for 20 minutes each night, try completing a couple addition and subtraction problems too.
