

- WEEKLY: Each week students will need to study spelling words and vocabulary words Testing is on Thursday and Friday. Use the Unit Spelling List that is located in your child's binder to help practice the words at home.
- WEDNESDAY: Study vocabulary words. Quiz on Thursday.
- THURSDAY: Study spelling words.
- AS NEEDED: Study for tests and quizzes.

bolicy for homework

- **Weekly**: Students will need to get to a green light on Reflex Math three times by Friday. Students can access Reflex Math from home, but will also be given opportunities in class to reach their green lights. This online tool helps students with math fact fluency in addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division.
- Thursday: Each week, students will complete a Daily Math Review (DMR) for their morning work.
 There will be a DMR quiz every Friday to assess their understanding on that weeks skills.
 Students will highlight questions on their DMR each Thursday and take it home to practice. They will return this on Friday with a parent signature.
- As needed: Study for quizzes and tests. Study guides will be given for all major tests.

classloom behavior

- Our main form of communication is Parent Square. This app will be used for behavior, communication, and reminders.
- The Class point system is used to create a POSITIVE classroom environment and to encourage your child to exhibit positive behavior throughout the day.
- Please understand that negative behaviors impede the learning of others, especially your child, and we want to make this system as fair as possible for everyone.
 - This system has been agreed upon by the teachers and administration, and it will be fully enforced beginning the first day of school.



Mrs. Finch's Sunday Call-Out


In order to receive Mrs. Finch's Sunday call-out message, the telephone number in PowerSchool must be correct.
