Introduction/Nominations/Elections:

- Meeting began at 8am via zoom. Mr. Sams introduced everyone who was attending and opened up nominations for three open positions. FMMS council was looking for 1 parent-business person for 1 year term and another parent for a 2 year term as well a 1 year parent member. Mrs. Renteria-Silva and Mrs. Hester were both nominated. Principal Report:

- **Covid Procedures and Update:** Feagin Mill is still following Covid protocol such as hand sanitizer stations, dividers on the classroom tables, lightened load in cafeteria, and monitoring quarantines.
- **After School Tutoring:** Mr. Sams mentioned the After School Program (ASP) is in place Monday through Thursday each week and the cafeteria workers are providing a snack.
- **Pack Time:** It is taking place on Tuesdays and Thursdays each week. Data is being used to help create the courses. Parents can view the courses being offered for this (remediation and enrichment) to help their child choose where they should go during this time.
- **Technology Update:** Every classroom now has a video board and in 2022-2023 school year, FM is hoping to have a 1 to 1 ratio with students and chromebooks. This will allow the students to take them home and work independently.

- **Renovations Summer of 2022:** Feagin Mill is 25 years old and is getting renovated with all new carpet, flooring, ceilings and lighting as well as painted and automatic bleachers in the gym.
- **Celebrating Great News:** Both football teams (7th and 8th) played for the championship. This is the first time in school history both teams were in it. Cheer team won the county championship this past Saturday with an excellent performance. Band, Ag, FCCLA, and FBLA are representing our school well. We have pigs in the barn and the band is growing. We will have a drama club and a FM pageant this school year. Canned food and sock drive went well. Students and teachers participated in Red Ribbon Week.
