The program involves students in raising funds for special projects without involving them in direct sales of merchandise.

### June Board Meeting

Members of the Board agreed to meet at 5:00 p.m. for the June 20, 2005, meeting in order to conduct the meeting prior to the Board of Commissioners Public Hearing on the budget.

#### **Budget Update**

Superintendent McRae reported that the state budget deliberations were ongoing and there was a possibility that the General Assembly would not be finished with the budget before July 1, 2005. Cuts in personnel are a real possibility and he stated that he had asked Jeanne Blackard, Director of Classified Personnel, to put a hold on hiring any new teacher assistants. He reminded the Board that there were some funds were available in the fund balance.

### 215 Day Calendar

Director of Classified Personnel Jeanne Blackard and Finance Officer Todd Lowe explained how the new calendar legislation had affected workdays and paydays for the 2005-2006 school year. Employees who were employed 220 days for the 2004-2005 school year will be employed 215 days for the 2005-2006 school year, but will continue to receive their first full month's salary no later than August 31, 2005 and each subsequent month thereafter. Employees employed less than or more than 220 days in 2004-2005 will continue to be employed less than or more than 215 days in 2005-2006 and will be paid no later than August 31, 2005, for time worked through the last day of that month, and each subsequent month thereafter.

#### Early College Program

Executive Director of Secondary Education Parks Allen reported that the school system had submitted a grant in cooperation with Randolph Community College to implement an Early College Program. Four hundred students, which would reflect the population of the Randolph County Schools, would be selected to participate in the program. One criteria of selection would be students which would be first generation college graduates. The 400-student school would be housed on the RCC campus and would be developed over a four-year period of time.

#### Update on Guil-Rand Fire Department Request

Attorney Bob Wilhoit reported that the City of Trinity would make a recommendation to the Randolph County Board of Commissioners on whether Fairgrove Fire Department or Guil-Rand Fire Department would provide services to the City of Trinity. He also stated, that no matter which department was selected for the city, it would not change the district lines for each department. Once Commissioners make a decision, the departments must be given a 180-day notice before the change is implemented. B. Coltrane made a motion seconded by G. Lawson that the Board give Attorney Wilhoit authorization to proceed with obtaining a release from the County Commissioners for a portion of the Hopewell School property sought by the Guil-Rand Fire Department for a sub-station. The property is now owned by County Commissioners as part of the property held for COPS funding. The motion carried: 7-0.
