## On Site Learning Space Available to current students beginning August 17, 2020 Hours 8:00am – 3:02pm

Free Safe Learning Space is available only to registered Premier High School students and will begin 8/17/2020. The end date is subject to change, depending on our actual return to brick and mortar instruction.

Students must register at least 72 hours or three school days in advance. Registration will begin at 8:00 am on Monday, August 10 and end at noon on Wednesday, August 12 to be eligible to begin on August 17. Consistent with the Governor's Executive Order, a maximum capacity has been set in order to mitigate the potential spread of COVID-19. This means that it is possible that not every registered student will be able to start on August 17. If program interest exceeds capacity, PHS will work to add additional sites as needed.

- Students may not arrive more than 15 minutes before their first scheduled class and may not stay later than 15 minutes after their last class ends.
- A teacher will not be available to students. Students will participate in classes via the virtual learning environment
- Staff may provide technical assistance (login, navigation, etc.) and help clarify questions. Tutoring is not available.
- Students will be expected to adhere to behavioral expectations in order to participate.
- Local, state and and national health agency recommendations are in place including hand sanitizing, social distancing, and face masks.
- PHS Waiver, Release, and Assumption of Risk form must be signed.

## **Prior to arrival:**

- Conduct home screening protocol before leaving your house
- Masks must be worn it is your responsibility to bring your own mask each day

## While you are on campus:

- Social distancing must be practiced
- Screening protocols are required to enter the building
- Use hand sanitizer once you are cleared to proceed into the building
- Visitors are not allowed
- Proceed directly into your assigned meeting space
  - Use hand sanitizer upon entering any room / classroom
- You may NOT access other spaces outside of your defined workspace
  - This includes all offices and other classrooms
- Use a disinfectant wipe or cleaner to clean the surface of all common devices and desktop space. Also, clean hard chair surface with disinfectant wipe or cleaner.
- Do NOT share items with others.
- Place borrowed supplies ie: pencils / pens in the "sanitize" area
- Only borrow sanitized material
- Tell the person monitoring the room if you need to use the restroom
- Wash your hands with soap for at least 20 seconds prior to leaving the restroom use a paper towel to dry your hands
