OCTOBER 19, 2021 FPTC Student Aid CRRSAA HEERF II Status of Emergency Relief to Students Reporting FINAL REPORT

This is a posting of CRRSAA HEERF II "Student Portion" information for quarterly reporting compliance in accordance with the Section 18004(e) of the CARES Act:

- Florida Panhandle Technical College (FPTC) signed and returned to the Department of Education, the Certification and Agreement statement. FPTC will use no less than 50 percent of the funds received from the CRRSAA HEERF II ACT to provide no less than 50% of the total Student and Institutional Emergency Financial Aid Grant Funds to students.
- 2. FPTC received a total of \$189,031 from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants directly to students, completely exhausted and distributed by November, 2020. Another \$ which was 189,031.00 for students was mirrored and provided to FPTC as additional funds, receive by FPTC in May 2020 under the CRRSAA HEERF II, added to the original grant ACT.
- 3. As of this posting, all monies of the CRRSAA HEERF II ACT have been distributed directly to students and no monies are available for additional distribution. All receiving students exhibited "exceptional need" as a result of the COVID 19 pandemic.
- 4. The act required that eligible students be enrolled in an eligible Title IV CTE program, not be in default of loans, not have fraudulently received Title IV funds, and not be a dual enrollment or a FAFSA adult education learner. FPTC ask eligible students to complete a current FAFSA. All students receiving funds completed a W9 and application for funds. Students who met this criteria, and had "exceptional needs" were eligible to apply for the funding during the Spring and Summer Terms of the 21-22 school year.
