- Conferences will be scheduled based upon teacher availability
- Teachers can be contacted via student's agenda, email, class dojo, remind, or school phone
- Non-English-speaking parents will have access to a bilingual staff member to help with translations

- Volunteer trainings are scheduled at the beginning of each school year
