Class DOJO

- We will be using Class DOJO as our main source of communication. If you need to change your child's transportation please message your child's teacher. However, your child is absent please send a note and make sure they give it to their teacher. That note has to be turned into the office. All behavior is also monitored on Class DOJO.

Communication FOLDERS

Communication folders go home every Wednesday. Please sign the papers in the "return to school" pocket and return them by Friday. Feel free to go over the papers your child may have struggled with. If you would like to keep them over the weekend to go over with your child please let their teacher know.

BEHAVIOR

*School-wide, we follow the 3 B's: Be Safe, Be Respectful, Be Responsible. Students are reminded of these daily. Those that follow the 3 B's receive positive points in Class Dojo. Those who do not, will lose points in Class Dojo.

*If your child continues to make poor choices even after he/she has lost points in Class Dojo, it may result in a PFI (Plan for Improvement) or an Office Referral depending on the offense.

9-WEEK CELEBRATION

- Each week your child may earn **15 points** for attendance (3 points a day).
- They also have the opportunity to earn points for positive behavior choices .
- Students that receive the required amount of points will attend that nine weeks celebration.
- If you have any questions about celebrations, feel free to contact Mr. Dewitt.

READING PROGRAM

- Our students participate in Reading Workshop daily.
- Students read books on their individual levels while the teachers are working with a small group or individual conference with a student. Students also have a Reading Journal that they jot the reading assignment in for that day.
- Students should read at home daily for at least 20 minutes. A good time to do this would be sitting at the table while supper is being cooked or right before they go to bed to help them wind down. Also, make time for your child to talk about their book to make sure they are comprehending it.

RECORD OF PROGRESS

- Second grade uses the Record of Progress. It is very similar to the one Kindergarten and First Grade uses. However, the standards are different.
- Conferences will be set up in October to discuss not only your child's progress so far this year but also to familiarize you with the Record of Progress. All parents are required to attend the conference before their child's ROP goes home.
