Latin Honors Distinctions

Pioneer Valley High School follows the Latin Honors system, granting Top Performing Students to be recognized with one of three honors distinctions at graduation:

Summa Cum Laude, Cum Laude, or Magna Cum Laude

- 1. To earn the distinction of *Summa Cum Laude* (with highest honor), a student must have earned a total weighted grade point average of at least 4.2000.
- 2. To earn the distinction of *Magna Cum Laude* (with great honor), a student must have earned a total weighted grade point average of at least 4.0 and less than 4.199.
- 3. To earn the distinction of *Cum Laude* (with honor), a student must have earned a total weighted grade point average of at least 3.8 and less than 3.99

All coursework offered by an accredited institution (including colleges) will be included when determining honors distinctions.
